

This funding serves approximately *5.7 percent* of the eligible, at-need population in Florida.

## **Eligibility Requirements:**

- Females between 50 and 64 years of age, and
- Household income at or below 200% of the Federal Poverty Level, and
- Uninsured or no insurance that covers screenings.
