Breast Milk Storage Guidelines



	Storage type	Storage time
A	Room temperature, 25 °C or colder	Up to 4 hours
	Cooler with frozen ice packs	Up to 24 hours
	Refrigerator set to 3.8 °C or below	Up to 3 days
	Freezer set to -17.8 °C or below	Up to 6 months
	Deep freezer set to -20 °C	Up to 12 months

Note: These guidelines are for freshly expressed or pumped breast mil



Storage and Preparation of Breastmilk

Tips for Safely Thawing Frozen Breast Milk



Defrost the oldest bottle of breast milk first



Do not thaw breast milk at room temperature place it in the refrigerator or in a bowl of warm water



Do not use the microwave or place your breast milk in a pot of boiling water on the stove



Once defrosted, warm up breast milk and use immediately



Florida Breast and Cervical Cancer Early Detection Program



Services provided include:

- Breast and cervical cancer screening exams (clinical breast exams, mammograms, and Pap tests).
- Care coordination to all clients with abnormal exams.
- Women screened through the program and diagnosed with breast or cervical cancer are referred to the Florida Medicaid Program for eligibility determination.
- Paid breast and cervical cancer treatment through Medicaid for eligible women screened through the program.
